Uniform Washing Instructions

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY!

First Step:

 REMOVE elastic clips from bottom of uniform pants. DO NOT wash gauntlets or spats.

Stains:

If a stain does occur, sponge with water or treat with an appropriate product before it
has time to set and before laundering. You may use "Spray and Wash" and other nonchlorine stain removers when washing. Use only non-chlorine detergent! Many
detergents are harsh and have a bleaching ingredient that will cause even colorfast
fabric to migrate.

Washing Jackets and Bib Pants:

- Avoid washing bib pants and jackets together!
- Never wash in hot water! Please wash on gentle or cool.
- Machine wash on the **gentle / permanent press cycle**, but do not overload machines.
- Use only non-chlorine household laundry detergent.
- Do not use liquid fabric softener on band uniforms!

Drying:

- At cycle completion place garments in dryer, and dry on cool/permanent press setting.
- A softener sheet may be used in the dryer, however, use only one (1) sheet per dry load.
- Caution: Do NOT use a hot dryer setting! A hot dryer setting will remove the press.
 When dried on a cool or permanent press setting, uniforms will require very little touch up.
- Remove garments from the dryer and place on a hanger immediately.

<u>Ironing:</u>

 Jackets and pants are made of completely washable polyester-gabardine material. Please use a low heat to iron any wrinkles if necessary.
